


Sunday Series Autumn 2022



## Title: Renewed in the Image of our Maker

Speaker: Jamie Lotinga (City West) Bible Ref: Colossians 3: 5-11

#### **Overview**

In these verses Paul tells us to put to death whatever belongs to our earthly nature. The earthly nature is the drive in us to over-desire earthly things – its when we need them in order to feel alive, secure and like we are worth something. The thrill of sexual sin can, for a fleeting moment, make us feel alive and connected to beauty. The hoarding of money we don't need can make us feel more secure and the achievement of success and status in career can make us feel more important and like we are worth something. When such needs are threatened by others we can lash out in anger, especially if we find ourselves being criticised. We are new creations in Christ, beloved children of our Father and all our failings are forgiven. We can now live free of these old habits of earthly nature and so we put them to death as we trust and experience God's love for us and live life led by His Spirit. The more we trust and experience his personal love for us, the more we know him by heart and the more we are changed into his image of love. We are made by God and for God and are made complete in his love - we no longer need earthly things in order to feel alive, secure and worth something. It is the Holy Spirit that makes God's love real to us and pours it into our hearts. As we are filled by the Spirit and follow His leading each day, we grow in the fruit of the Spirit and live by our new nature in Christ.

## Putting it to Death

(Consider the roles of the Holy Spirit e.g. counsellor, helper, leads us into all truth, grows fruit of the Spirit in us, gives us words when we need to speak, consider also that Ephesians 6 describes the Word of God as being a sword of the Spirit... there's more but this list is a start!)
