Title: The Saviour to come

Overview

Advent marks the start of the Church year. Happy New Year! It's part of a rhythm of seasons through the year, leading to Christmas, Epiphany, Lent, Easter, Pentecost, Ascension, and so back to Advent.

At Advent the church lights a fresh candle each week over the four weeks, symbolising the approaching light of the world, whose birth we will celebrate at Christmas.

Advent is a time for reflection, for hearing the voice of God, and responding in faith. It's a busy time naturally in the lead up to Christmas, but a time when we should make space to hear from God, intentionally seeking Him, hearing His voice in the Word and in prayer and worship, refreshing our faith and strength for the next season.

Finding time to hear from God

There are less than 3 weeks to go until Christmas. No doubt you will be busy in the next few weeks, but:

- What is your preferred way of hearing from God?

The Grace of God

God's grace is freely given but was purchased at the immense, unimaginable cost of the life of his Son, Jesus. Jesus' death on the Cross paid the price for our sin. We are therefore able to be forgiven, we're born again, we'll be presented blameless on the day when Jesus returns. Let's not abuse that freely given grace, but let's live acknowledging God's continuing grace to us.
