Overview

Praying in the Spirit is praying as a dearly loved son/daughter of God to our heavenly Father (Rom 8:15-16; Matthew 6:9). Knowing we are children of God, we pray in the Spirit on all occasions, with all kinds of prayers and requests, alert to what is happening around us in the world, but also alert to how God wants to extend his kingdom. We keep on praying and don't give up, and we pray particularly for one another.

On all occasions

- Why can we pray anywhere anytime? (Psalm 139; 1 Cor 6:19; John 4:21)
- How can we / do we take advantage of the fact that we can pray anywhere anytime?

With all kinds of prayers...

- How would you describe the different sorts of prayers that you pray?
 (thanks giving, petition, questions, praise, listening, ...)
- Do you think our heavenly Father is more interested in hearing some prayers than others?

Being alert

- What do you see or hear that is prompting you to pray at the moment?
- What are you asking the Lord to do and why do you think he will do it?

Keep on praying

- What can tempt you to stop praying?
- What encourages you to keep on praying?

- Why does the Lord want us to pray for one another?
- Who can you pray for to know God's love more, and have the words and courage to share it with others?
